Lord's Prayer in Jesus' Language – Worship and Small Groups through October 15

The Lord's Prayer is probably the central prayer of the Christian community. It is the prayer that Jesus taught his disciples when they wanted him to teach them how to pray. In the Bible, it is found in both Matthew 6:9-13 and Luke 11:1-4. The version of the Lord's Prayer we are probably most familiar with is an adaptation of the King James Version. What we might not consider is that Jesus would have taught the prayer in the day-to-day language he spoke, which was Aramaic. We will be spending these

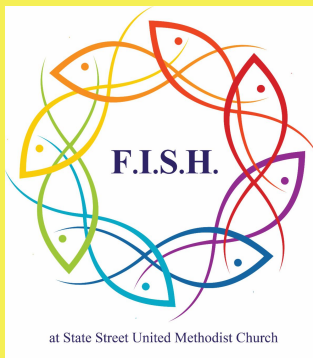

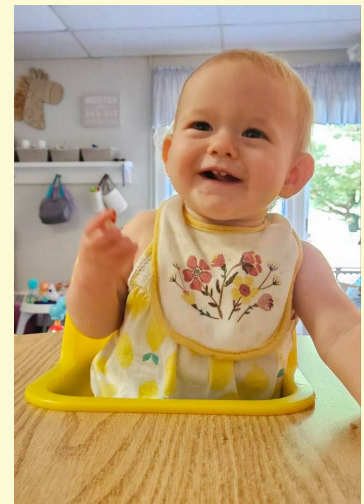

Openings for Altar Flower Memorials or Honorariums

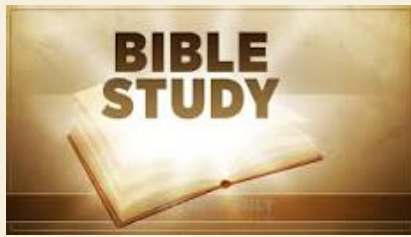
