Here are some things you can do to prepare:

- Think of others in your life you are missing. There will be an opportunity to write those names and memories on slips of paper. The slips of paper will be gathered together and will be ritually burned along with this year's Palm Sunday branches. The ashes will become part of our Ash Wednesday worship in February.
- Read Ruth 1:1-18. That is the scripture reading for Sunday. Think about the power
 of companionship you see in Ruth and Naomi's story. Give thanks for companions
 in your life who have helped you through the storms.
- If you are only able to join us online, prepare your own communion station (with some form of bread and juice/water). Also write down names and memories on a slip of paper. You can have your own ritual burning or email those names to the church office so that they become part of our celebration.
- Be in prayer for the families of those who have lost loved ones, that they may see glimpses of God's companionship in times of grief.

Daylight Saving Time ends at 2 a.m. on Sunday, November 5, when the clock will "fall back" one hour. Remember to set your clocks back one hour before going to sleep.


