Children, Youth, and Families are invited to an Easter Egg Hunt around the church! Come excited to find surprises and ready to have lots of fun! There will be dinner served!






- Palm/Passion Sunday on Sunday, March 24: Congregation-Wide Lunch and Easter Fun/Egg Hunt from noon to 2 pm


