

The Beyond Worship group which meets every Sunday at 4pm in the Parlor is taking a break (for the rest of May and June) but will resume Sunday, July 7.


Beyond Worship welcomes all who are interested in open, respectful conversations about our faith, the Bible, and even worship experiences.

The Prayer Chain is seeking additional new members who will pray for those in need.


