



Voting delegates from around the world will be considering over 1,000 different petitions and proposals. The theme for the Conference is "And Know That I Am God" from Psalm 46. Our Bishop and those representing our Holston Annual Conference have invited all of us to prayerfully read and meditate on this scripture passage reflecting on ways that you, your local church, churches throughout Holston and the United Methodist Church can more faithfully "be still and know that I am God." 


## State Street Is Hiring! Help Us Spread the Word!
