
Sermon: "Learning Through Suffering"

Hurricane Relief and Outreach Update

You are serving as the hands and feet of Jesus in response to our neighbors whose lives have been devastated by Hurricane Helene.

- 1,066 cleaning kits and 1,650 hygiene kits from Clinch Mountain District churches have already been distributed by our disaster relief coordinators.
- \$6,230 has been donated to State Street designated for the "Holston Flood Fund." This does not include direct donations.
- \$875 has been donated to State Street designated for the ministry of Fred and Libby Dearing in South Sudan, which means you are serving neighbors both near and far.

Current Needs

- If you know of families needing assistance cleaning out or gutting their homes, please contact the church office. Their information will be shared with the disaster relief coordinators as they are lining up work teams.
- The need for cleaning and hygiene kits and water is not as great now. Current needs are work gloves, rubber gloves and bleach.
- Feminine hygiene items are also being collected.
- These items can be brought to the church and will be delivered to the district office for distribution.

Work Teams – Pastor Laura is putting together a list of those who are interested in participating in volunteer work days. The need for volunteers of all abilities will become more and more needed, especially as we move into long-term recovery. 
