Soloists, in order of appearance, are Dr. Matthew Potterton, Timothy Landis, Sara Hrivnak, Mark Owen Davis, Jane Morison, Anne Proctor, and Kim Profitt. Accompanists are Steve Sensenig, piano; and Joy Smith-Briggs, organ. Robert Campbelle will conduct. In addition to the choirs of Central Presbyterian and State Street United Methodist Churches, members of the Voices of the Mountains and other area churches will perform the choruses. The meals will be handed out this year on Wednesday, November 27th. If you would like to help deliver meals, it's a great way to meet some very thankful families!




