# **Robert Clark Historical Marker**


On December 14, fifteen State Streeters joined a crowd of almost 200 to dedicate an historical marker in the neighborhood of the church at Citizen's Cemetery, which is located near the intersection of Piedmont and Valley Drives. Robert Clark was a 20 year old Black American who in 1891 was lynched in front of a crowd of cheering onlookers. Several of his ancestors were in attendance. We pray that the marker will not be vandalized and also that it may serve as a reminder for all of us to be people who stand up for anyone who is not treated with dignity or compassion.
