
January 12, 2025 Baptism of the Lord

At times we may be under the impression that a strong faith and questions do not go together. Everyone has doubts. Where is God when bad things happen? Does God hear our prayers? Is there a heaven? How can we know? Using a resource by Rev. Adam Hamilton called "Wrestling with Doubt/Finding Faith," we will seek to strengthen our trust in God in a way that is unafraid of hard questions. Wrestle with doubt and find faith – belief and trust, not certainty; mystery rather than simple answers.
