




Shoes for Guatemalan Children

+ 11:00 a.m. in the Sanctuary – Traditional worship with choir and traditional hymns.




Godly Play (a worship experience for ages 4 - 4th grade) is offered at the 9.01 a.m. service, with the exception of Communion Sundays.
