Crossroads Medical Mission Day


On March 23, State Street celebrated our partnership with Crossroads Medical Mission. Founded in 2002 by State Street members and expanding in ways beyond imagination, Crossroads Medical has provided over 54,819 medical visits free of charge to patients through both its mobile clinic (the RV parked in the State Street parking lot) and now a free-standing location in downtown Bristol on the corner of Scott and Lee Streets. Cindy Rockett, one of those State Street legends, is retiring as Executive Director and Erin Faust, who also has State Street connections, has now taken on that role. On staff is also Amy Brown, former State Street staff member, who is serving in development and community relations. + 11:00 a.m. in the Sanctuary – Traditional worship with choir and traditional hymns.




Godly Play (a worship experience for ages 4 - 4th grade) is offered at the 9.01 a.m. service, with the exception of Communion Sundays.
