Psalm 14: A Prayer of Lament, and Faith

On Sunday September 14 using Psalm 14 as our guide, we joined in the Bible-based practice of lament. The lament voiced our concern about the violence we see in our own country and around the world, we lamented the oppression of the poor and others in our society. We lamented the rhetoric that divides us and has made conversation about the grace of God expressed in the Psalm harder and harder to share with one another. We lamented the self-focus in our world that God described in the Psalm. The lament closed with the plea Come, Lord Jesus, Come sung by Mandi Regin. We offer this reflection as an opportunity to continue to turn to God in the midst of our grief, anger and confusion. Come, Lord Jesus, come.
