As of December 4, we have received 67 pledges with a total so far of \$365,144.67. This is a big jump from the last report. After all pledges had come in in 2025, we received 69 pledges for a total of \$400,390.18 of the 2026 pledges are new and 28 of the regular pledgers have increased their pledge amount. Keep those pledges coming. We know in challenging times, turning in that pledge can be an act of faith and we thank you for your investment in the work of the church. 


Speedway in Lights: A Bright & Merry Night!
